Getting started

Windows users double-click: click_me.exe Macintosh users double-click: click_me

Windows users press: Ctrl F Macintosh users press: Option F

Return to Normal Screen size

To temporarily disable this, choose "Allow Blocked Content..." then "Yes".

To permanently stop the Information bar from blocking file and software downloads

- 1) Open Internet Explorer.
- 2) Click the Tools button, and then click Internet Options.
- 3) Click the Security tab, and then click Custom level.
- 4) Do one or both of the following:
 - a. To turn off the Information bar for file downloads, scroll to the Downloads section of the list, and then, under Automatic prompting for file downloads, click Enable.
 - b. To turn off the Information bar for ActiveX controls, scroll to the ActiveX controls and plug-ins section of the list, and then, under Automatic prompting for ActiveX controls, click Enable.
- 5) Click OK, click Yes to confirm that you want to make the change, and then click OK again.
